


- 1. https://www.thinglink.com/ The internet page is entered.





5. When we log into the platform, we will see a page as shown below.





6. Click on the "Create" button on the upper right side of the page.





7. The "Blank canvas" button is clicked on the page that opens, depending on the preference. Then click the "Continue" button to continue.





8. Click the "**Upload**" button on the top right of the page that opens, and then click the "**Upload** files" button to select the file we want to use for the background.





12. On the page that opens;


- 1. It is the area that allows us to make arrangements on the page. Here we can add new tags to the page and edit these tags.


13. When we click on the field number 1 (Image 11) to add a new tag, the page that opens;


14. Click on the "Add tag" button to continue. On the page that opens, the relevant field is selected according to the type of tag we want to add.


15. On the page that opens;
